The peer-reviewed *Zeitschrift für Semiotik/Journal of Semiotics*, founded in 1979, is the official publication organ of the German Semiotics Society (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Semiotik). The journal is indexed in Scopus and in Erih Plus.

The journal brings into focus themes from all fields of semiotics, organized by guest editors. Manuscripts will undergo a process of external peer review. The main criteria for publication are innovativeness, depth of engagement with semiotic traditions and theories, and analytical precision.

Traditionally, the journal published only German-language articles. However, the journal has recently changed its policy. Issues can now contain up to 50 % of English-language content, with the remaining content in German.
